HISTORY OF GACLEA

The Georgia Association of Campus Law Enforcement Administrators (GACLEA) was founded in 1974.

The first organizational meeting took place on October 9, 1974 at Emory University in Atlanta Georgia.

The Association sought to promote communication and cooperation among the colleges and universities in the state of Georgia.

It's primary focus, *to have a positive impact upon the professional development of campus law enforcement services*, continues today.

GACLEA began with fourteen members representing 12 institutions. Today the association has over 90 members representing over 60 institutions.

GACLEA has played an active role in developing and supporting legislation that affect our profession.

The association also sponsors and provides numerous opportunities for training relevant to campus law enforcement personnel.



NIMS Training at VSU

Chief Scott Doner has offered 24 hours of GACP and POST approved training on the Incident Command System (ICS) from IACLEA at the winter meeting in Valdosta GA.

The training is scheduled before the GACLEA business meeting to be held on

March 2nd in the Rose Room of the University Center at VSU. There is a \$30 registration fee for the business meeting.

The three day training program will begin on February 27 and run through March 1st. It is NIMS compliant training and the training is **free** of charge.

The ICS training will take place at the Continuing Education Bldg room 204 at VSU.
